
– 50th Anniversary Celebration – MORRIS SCHOOL DISTRICT LEGACY

In 1972, the District embarked on a historic journey to unite our communities and impact our students for generations to come. Throughout these 50 years, the District has worked to maintain and support diversity, equity and inclusion in our schools.



District and community members alike are deeply committed to protecting and perpetuating the unique legacy of the Morris School District.

The Morris Educational Foundation (MEF) was subsequently founded in 1992 by Stephen B. Wiley, lead counsel in the MSD merger, to generate and distribute resources to support and enhance MSD schools. This partnership has helped the District continue to be a model of visionary social and educational leadership in New Jersey and the country.
